GRADING

TESTS 60 %

Each chapter will conclude with a test. Each test will have the same format. They will begin with several short answer questions related to topics learned during the unit. Next will be approximately 15 multiple-choice questions. Following the multiple-choice section, you will have approximately 15 modified true or false questions. Labeling diagrams and matching will round out the rest of the test. You will know what diagrams you will need to study prior to each test. The day before each test you will be given a large index card to handwrite or draw anything you may find helpful. You can use this card when you take your test. You will only be given a card if your class notes are filled in. Extra credit will also be offered on every test.

HOMEWORK 10 %

A homework packet will be given near the beginning of each unit. Each night you will work on specific sections or questions. The homework packet is a great study guide for the upcoming test. Homework will be checked for completeness. Failure to have it done when I check it will result in a ZERO. Homework CANNOT be made up.

INTERNET PROJECTS 30 %

Every other week we will meet in the library or learning center to work on Internet assignments based on what we have learned in class or are about to learn. These will be done using Google drive and submitted to me via e-mail. Each project will be a mini presentation, where each slide answers a specific question and may include a picture. Each piece of information must be cited using class notes or the website where the information was obtained. Citations will be done using easybib.com. I will have a video and rubric available on my website to show the proper procedure. Each presentation will be due by midnight on the Sunday that follows the project. Presentations up to one week late will lose 10 points. If the presentation is more than 1 week late, 35 points will be deducted.
